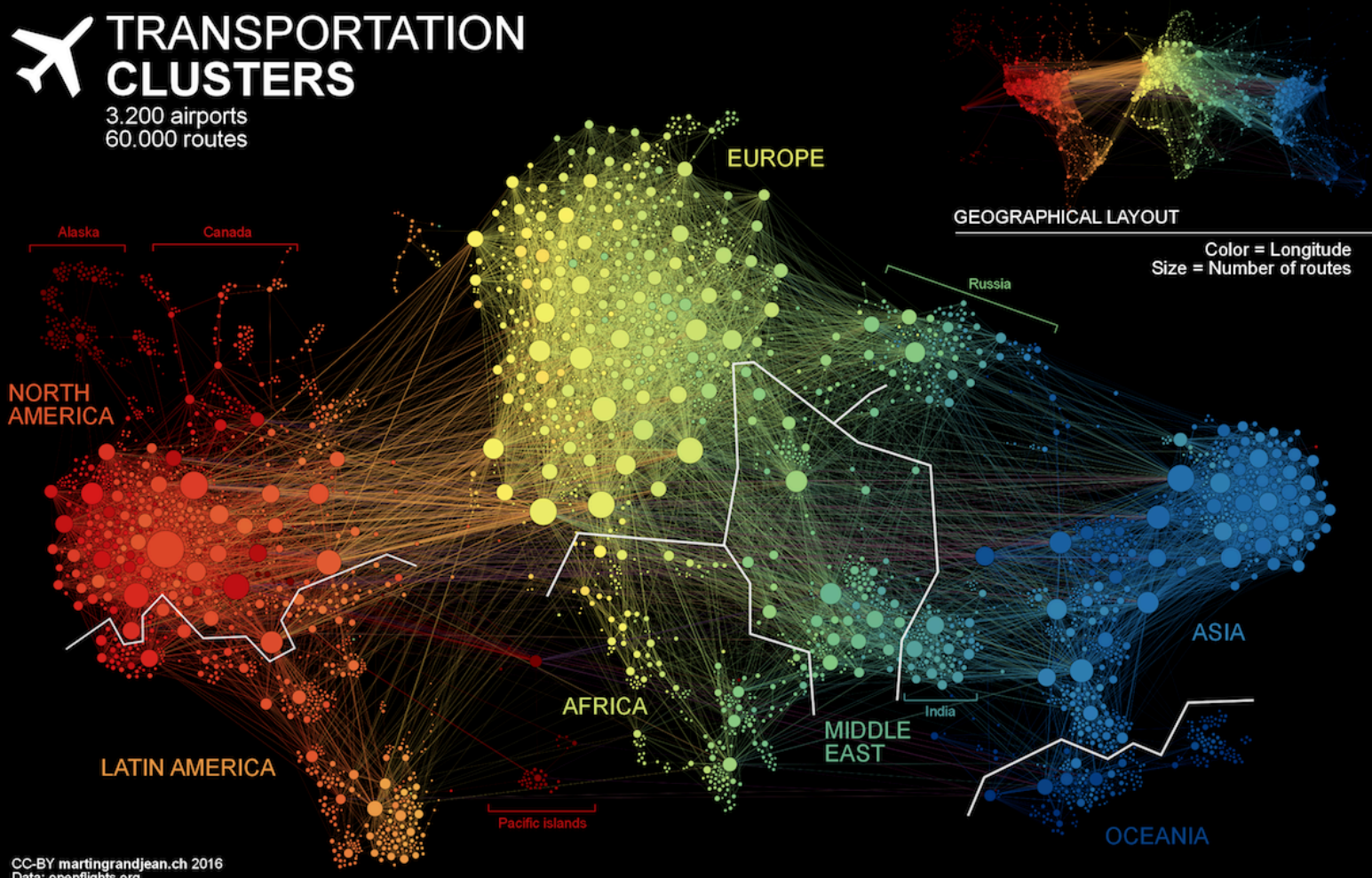


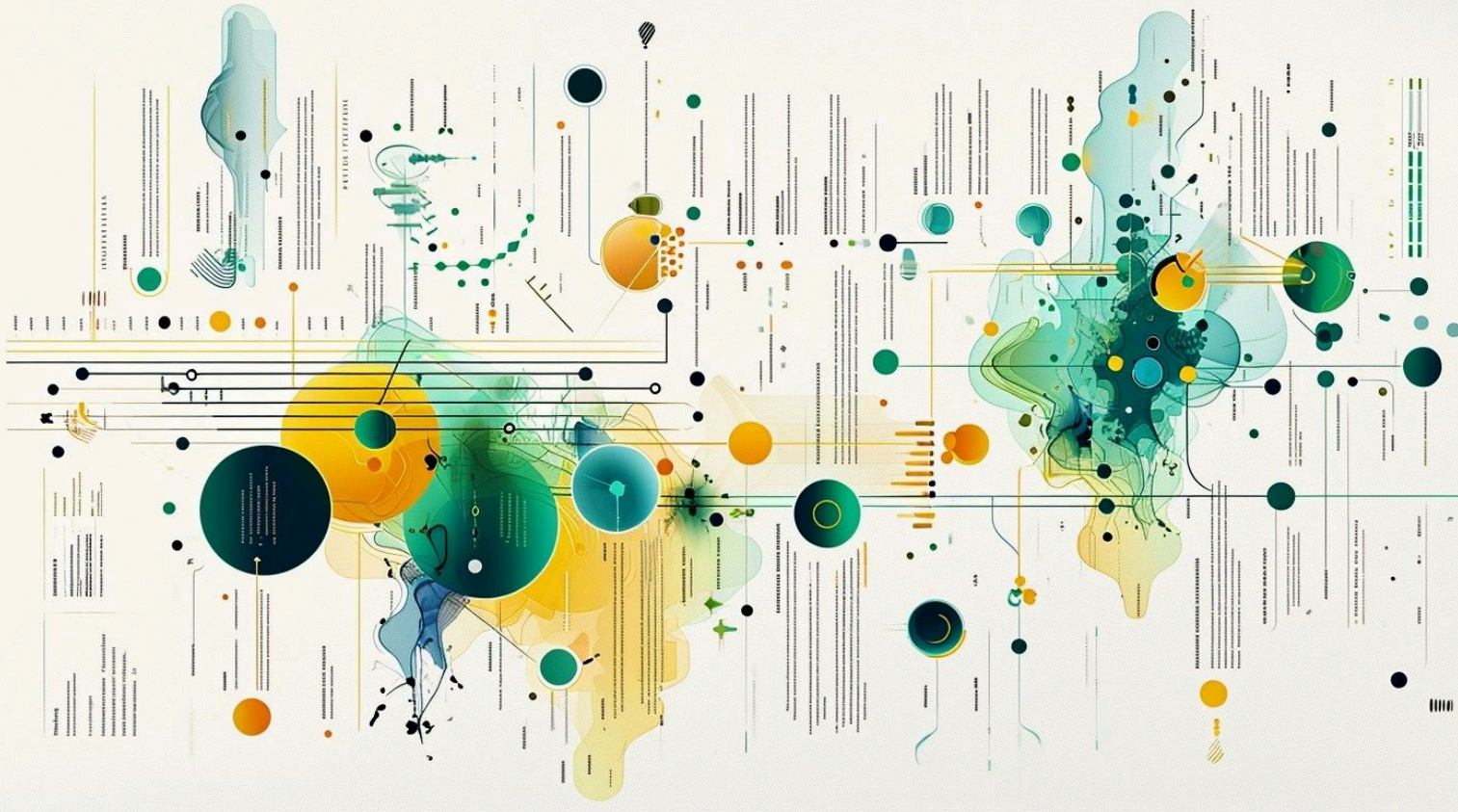

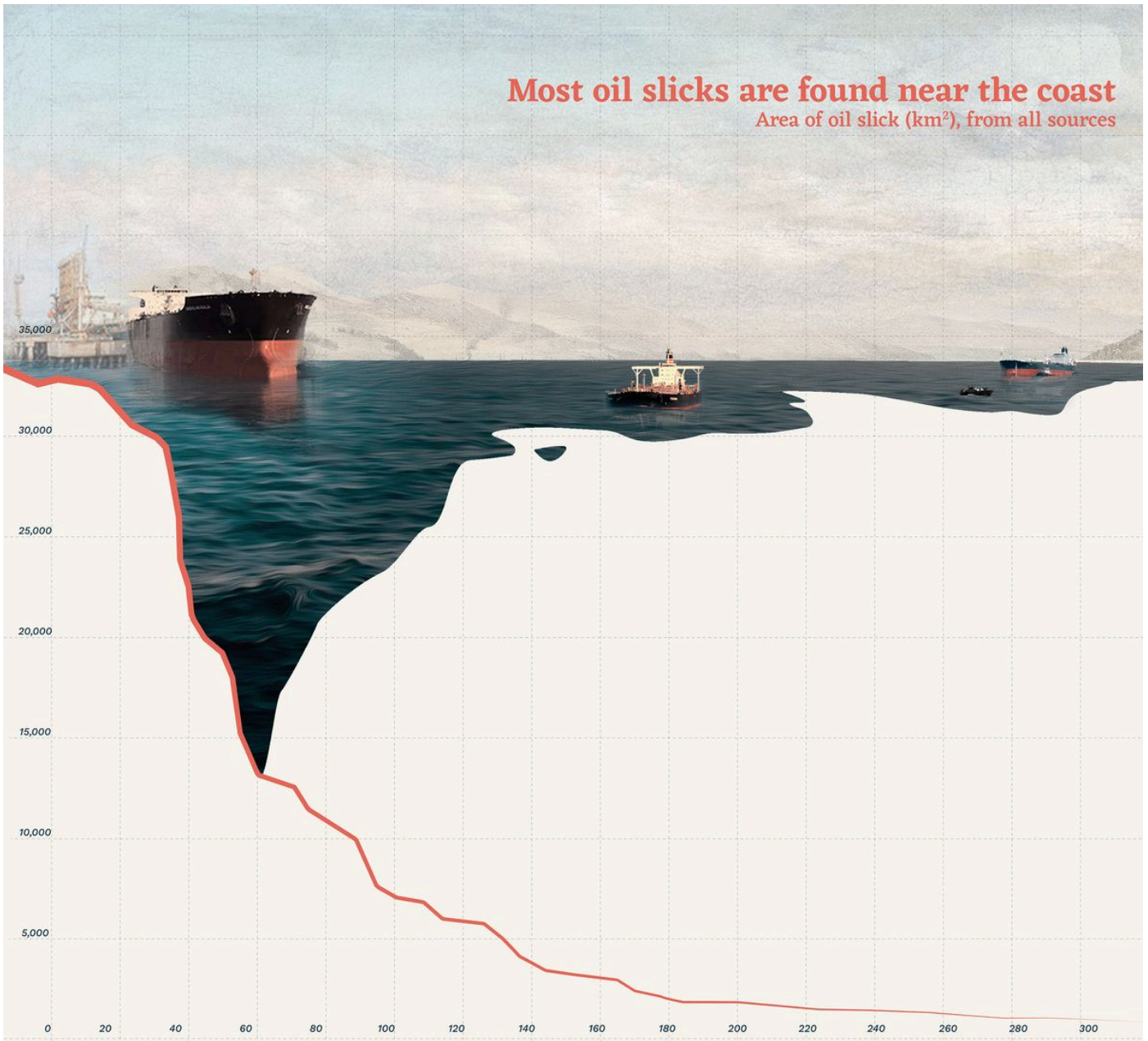






## Most oil slicks are found near the coast
