

During the daytime

The Zuiderdiep is one of the busiest public transport corridors in Groningen and serves as a central artery for both city and regional bus traffic. Starting during early morning, the street experiences a nearly continuous flow of buses operated mainly by *QBUZZ*.

The zuiderdiep links Groningen Central Station with the eastern and northern parts of the city while also acting as a transfer route for buses traveling to surrounding towns and provinces.

Daytime activity on the Zuiderdiep

Begins early, usually before 06:00, when the first travellers enter the city centre. During peak morning hours, buses arrive every few minutes.

Q-link routes form the backbone of the network.

Because Groningen has a large student population and relatively low car ownership, daytime bus usage is very high compared to cities of similar size in the Netherlands.

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
